9. Summer Camp and the Requirements for Opening Up. Below are a few items that were pulled from a TAP article regarding Day Camp Opening. There is a lot more than this, more info to come.

- Face coverings should be worn when social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Campers and staff will be screened for fever and signs of COVID-19 prior to being permitted into the facility or participate in camp programming/
- Anyone with a fever or other sign of illness must not be admitted to camp.
- Campers and staff members should be educated on steps to prevent the steps of COVID-19.
- Groups should include the same children each day, and the same staff member if possible.
- Mixing between the above groups should be restricted.
- Camps should avoid communal dining and stagger meal times to ensure social distancing of groups.
- Surfaces must be cleaned and sanitized between each meal service.
- Staff is encouraged to wear cloth masks while working unless doing so would interfere with individuals health or if an individual is outside in extreme heat, or if the individual is in the water.
- Face coverings should be worn by campers, with children under the age 2 being the exception.
- Camps are prohibited from activities engaging in full-contact sports, and offsite events.
- Numerous soap and hand sanitizer stations should be provided.
- Gloves should be worn when serving food.
- Social distancing is encouraged during busing to and from camp.
- Vehicles should be clean and disinfected between use.
