

Free Measles Vaccines Provided by Union County

The Union County Board of Chosen Freeholders informs residents that children who are at least 12 months old and under age 19 and who are Medicaid eligible, uninsured or underinsured are eligible to receive free vaccines to prevent measles. This free service is available at the County's Immunization Clinic operated by the Union County Department of Human Services, Division of Social Services.

Appointments are required and residents may call 908-965-3627 or 908-965-3868 to schedule. The county's clinic is located at 40 Parker Road, Elizabeth, and is open Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
