# 2023 Road Paving

Below is our *tentative* road paving list for 2023; we hope to get all roads completed within available funds. There is always a chance that costs increase and alter this list for 2023. We will continue to seek out more outside funding for roads and other township infrastructure.

In 2023, we have roads being paved with a variety of funding sources and from a number of contractors. Roads will be paved and drainage designed where necessary through: budget funds in the 2023 municipal budget, grants, or via the utility companies (PSE&G and NJ American Water, specifically). Below is the breakdown. We will update with paving schedules once we receive start dates from the contractors/utility companies.

## COOP ROADS, THROUGH TOWNSHIP

This work strictly involves paving - no drainage, curbing, etc. - unless otherwise noted. Paving is tentatively scheduled to begin near the end of June. More roads may be added to this list as funds allow throughout the paving season.

- Kline Blvd (from the New Providence border to the power lines)
- Lorraine Drive
- Berkshire Drive
- Locust Ave (from recently paved portion to Snyder Ave)
- Overhill Way
- Pinewood Crescent
- Holly Mews
- Killarney Drive
- Branko Road
- North Road
- Summit Avenue
- Greg Court (most likely)
- Mary Court (most likely)
- Highland Circle (most likely)
- Heather Court (most likely)

## PSE&G ROADS - JUNE

The following roads will be paved by PSE&G after their Fall 2022 infrastructure work; paving is expected to start in June:

- Baker Ave.
- Honeyman Pl
- Delmore Ave
- Marion Ave
- Raleigh Ct
- Exeter Dr
- Allen Terr.

## PSE&G ROADS - LATE SUMMER/EARLY FALL

Roads near Governor Livingston/Murray Hill currently underground gas line infrastructure construction. Trenches dug need at least 2 months to settle after construction is complete, before paving can begin.

NJ American Water Roads

- Park Avenue (*paving start date to be scheduled after construction is complete; TBD*)

GRANT PROJECTS INVOLVING ROADS

- Kline Place & Fickler - DOT grant; waiting on DOT approval to start job
- Orion Drainage Improvements & Paving - start date TBD

**A note on how paving dates are determined when drainage has been added or the utility companies have installed new infrastructure underground:** the trenches created in the asphalt as a result of this underground work often takes about 2-3 months to settle, before paving can begin. This is to ensure there are no “soft spots” in the newly paved road. This is also why it may seem as if the utility companies have “just left” the roads in poor condition - just putting asphalt over the strips where they worked. Some time is required to pass before they can pave.
